# THE JACK LOADER RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP

## CONDITIONS OF AWARD

**Please retain these Conditions of Award as this document forms part of the agreement with the Rosemary Foundation for Memory Support Inc.**

### 1 PURPOSE

The Jack Loader Research Scholarship will be awarded as an add-on to other post-graduate awards such as the APA. Its purpose is to encourage postgraduate, research into dementia, in particular Alzheimer's Disease, and related disorders and/or the consequences of these diseases or disorders and as additional financial support for a suitably qualified graduate undertaking a program of study leading to a research higher degree at one of the South Australian universities. The successful applicant will be able to demonstrate **the relevance of their proposed research project to Alzheimer's Disease or related dementia or to the care provided for someone diagnosed with dementia** and, without restricting the possible disciplinary areas, might fall within areas such as clinical medicine; physical, social and behavioural sciences; pharmacology; human biology or information technology. It might include areas of study such as assistive technology; reducing carer stress; medications; dementia care; reducing the risk of dementia; nutrition ; or acute, residential and community care.

To receive the Scholarship an applicant will need to show that they have been accepted for admission to an appropriate Faculty at one of the South Australian universities.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY

An award holder must:

- be an Australian citizen; or permanent resident of Australia
- be enrolled full-time in a postgraduate degree for a Masters, PhD or professional research Doctorate at one of the South Australian universities;
- hold an Honours degree at the level of Second Class (upper division) or above, or an equivalent qualification.

### 3 SELECTION

The award of The Jack Loader Research Scholarship shall be determined from suitably qualified applicants by a selection panel appointed by The Rosemary Foundation for Memory Support Inc. in conjunction with Alzheimer's Australia S.A. Inc. The conditions for selection are set out in the **Application and information Guidelines**. Short listed candidates should be prepared to undertake an interview by the selection panel.

### 4 PERIOD OF TENURE

The scholarship is tenable for a period of twelve months from the date of offer of the award. Subject to satisfactory student progress reports, the award may be renewable for further periods of one year up to a maximum of three years.

### 5 STIPEND

The stipend for the scholarship will comprise \$8,000 payable through the successful applicant's university.

## 6 ALLOWANCES

An allowance of up to \$2000 towards attendance at an appropriate conference or similar activity or to assist with thesis production shall be payable upon application to the Rosemary foundation. Students claiming this allowance must produce original documentation showing the service and the amount to be paid or in the case that payment has been made receipts for the payment.

**A student claiming for the thesis allowance must lodge their claim within six months of the date of approval that all requirements for the degree have been completed.**

## 7 REGISTRATION AND ESTABLISHMENT

Following acceptance of the Scholarship, The Rosemary Foundation will make arrangements with the home university for the payment of the Scholarship.

Up to three Loader Scholarships may be awarded at any one time.

A Loader Scholar who makes satisfactory progress during the period for which the Scholarship was awarded may apply to continue the scholarship for a further year up to a maximum of three years.

The Foundation Board reserves the right to make no award, where in its opinion, there is no suitable candidate or in its judgment the proposed research is not consistent with the objectives of the award.

## 8 INTERMISSION

Award holders who discontinue their studies without permission may be required to repay any award payments made after the date on which it is determined that they effectively discontinued their studies.

## 9 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Any intellectual property arising as a result of the research carried out in relation to this award, shall be in accordance with the home university procedures.

## 10 ANNUAL REPORT

The Jack Loader Research Scholar will be required to complete an Annual Review of Progress report for The Rosemary Foundation in each year of tenure. The award may be withheld if an award holder fails at any time to make satisfactory progress.

The university may, at its discretion, require an award holder to submit additional progress reports.
